The number on the map (Figure 8) must be connected to Table 3. So on the map you can see the distribution of the species in Table 3.

Please, use 30-40 informants

Recommendation: Revisions Required

Reviewer F:

This is interesting research. from review, some comments as below:

1. The article could be more interesting if it focused on conservation efforts rather than describing cultivation.
2. Additional information is needed (additional table) describing the use, economic value, rate of utilization a year, etc
3. Some information is still contradictory such as in the finding section states good conservation but in the discussion section, lost vegetation is evident (bad conservation ?).
4. Please check the latine name properly
5. Many text explanation is not similar to the data presented in tables. Example: Table 3, duplicate latine name but different local name (is it similar species or different)
6. Please add the reference to support the statement that was not obtained from the research finding
7. Detail of comment as stated in the manuscript (attached)
