We have reached a decision regarding your submission entitled Implementation of Shannon Entropy Analysis on NIR Spectra for Nondestructively Determining of Water Content in Oil Palm Fresh Fruit Bunch" to International Journal of Electrical and Computer Engineering (IJECE)", a Scopus-indexed journal, Scimago Journal Ranking (SJR) Q2.

Our decision is to: REJECT and submit it elsewhere, due to one or more of the below reasons.

2. We do not appreciate a local journal with a local language as a reference. We strongly recommend you replace this reference with another one from an international journal that uses English.

3. Fig 1 : Avoid crowded plots in the figure, use only three or four data sets per image; use well-selected scales. Use clear symbols and data sets that are easy to distinguish.

- The substantial contribution and/or presentation of the paper is not suitable for a Scopus-indexed journal (SJR Q2).

- The figures or tables do not include relevant titles, captions, and descriptions in English.

- The figures or tables are not cited properly in the text.

- The quality of the figures is poor.

- The quality of the references is not suitable.

- Each citation is not written in the order of appearance in the text. Citations and references are not sequential. (All references mentioned in the Reference list are NOT cited in the text, and vice versa.)

- The paper contains a high proportion of self-citations.

- The manuscript has a high similarity rate (high potential plagiarism).

- Authors do not adhere to the style requirements as outlined in the guideline for authors.

- Authors do not comply with requirements for publication within the timeframe, even after extra time, example: Authors do not prepare a final camera-ready paper properly and do not pay the publication fee within the time frame.

- Authors failed to submit revised papers within the allotted time.

- Other reasons.

A good research paper has a clear statement of the problem the paper is addressing, the proposed solution(s), and the results achieved. It describes clearly what has been done before about the problem, and what is new.

IMPORTANT

1. Introduction section: explain the context of the study and state the precise objective. An Introduction should contain the following three (3) parts:

- Background: Authors have to make clear what the context is. Ideally, authors should give an idea of the state-of-the-art of field the report is about.

- The Problem: If there was no problem, there would be no reason for writing a manuscript, and definitely no reason for reading it. So, please tell readers why they should proceed with reading. Experience shows that for this part a few lines are often sufficient.

- The Proposed Solution: Now and only now! - Authors may outline the contribution of the manuscript. Here, authors have to make sure readers point out what are the novel aspects of authors' work.

Authors should place the paper in the proper context by citing relevant papers. At least 5 references (recent journal articles) are used in this section.

2. Method section: the presentation of the experimental methods should be clear and complete in every detail facilitating reproducibility by other scientists.

3. Results and discussion section: The presentation of results should be simple and straightforward in style. This section reports the most important findings, including results of statistical analyses as appropriate and comparisons to other research results. This is where the author(s) should explain in words what he/she/they discovered in the research. It should be clearly laid out and in a logical sequence. Discussion should be supported with suitable references. You should improve your analysis and present the comparison of your results to those obtained in similar studies. The "result and discussion" section reports the most important findings, including analyzing results as appropriate. It is very important to prove that your manuscript has significant value and is not trivial.

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
