Reviewer #1:

- 1. The abstract does a good job in presenting the study's objectives. However, to enhance clarity and alignment with the title, consider explicitly stating how the Construction Inquiry Learning model was applied. Additionally, include a brief mention of colloid materials in the abstract to ensure that the reader immediately connects the study's focus with the title.
- 2. The statistical results are presented adequately, but the explanation could be more detailed. Provide a concise interpretation of the t-test results, explaining the practical significance of the obtained t-value (54.069). Consider including information on the direction of the effect to give readers a better understanding of the impact of the guided inquiry learning model on student interest.
- 3. While the abstract provides insights into the positive outcomes, it would be beneficial to include a sentence or two about the study's limitations. Addressing any constraints or potential sources of bias will strengthen the credibility of the research. Moreover, briefly suggest possible avenues for future research related to the topic.
- 4. Elaborate more on the research design, specifically the rationale behind choosing the post-nontest, pre-nontest method. Discuss how this method aligns with the study's objectives and contributes to the validity of the results. Providing this context will help readers better understand the methodology and its appropriateness for the research question.
- 5. While the keywords are relevant, consider expanding them to enhance informativeness. For example, specify the type of inquiry learning model used (guided inquiry). This additional detail will assist researchers and educators looking for specific information related to guided inquiry learning and its impact on learning interest in the context of colloid materials at the high school level.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
