To enhance the credibility of the findings, include detailed statistical information in the results section, providing a comprehensive understanding of the study's outcomes.
- 3. The methodology section needs more details, such as the rationale behind choosing cluster random sampling and the specific steps taken in the survey. Additionally, elaborate on how the Likert-scale questionnaire was designed, validated, and administered. A thorough explanation will help readers assess the study's validity and reliability.
- 4. The article would benefit from a more extensive integration of relevant literature to contextualize the study. Incorporate existing theories and findings related to nursing service quality to provide a stronger foundation for the research. This will demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the field and highlight the novelty or significance of your study.
- 5. The discussion section should not only restate the results but also discuss their practical implications. How can the identified factors be practically applied to enhance nursing service quality? Consider providing recommendations for hospitals based on your findings, demonstrating the real-world relevance of the research.
