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#### **ABSTRAK**

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui apakah penggunaan cerita pendek efektif untuk mengembangkan kemampuan berbicara siswa di SMPN 160 Jakarta. Penelitian ini dilakukan dengan menggunakan metode kelompok control dan kelompok eksperimen dengan desain pretest-posttest dalam pengambilan data. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah siswa kelas delapan SMP N 160 Jakarta tahun ajaran 2017/2018. Sampel yang digunakan adalah kelompok siswa delapan E dan D. Kelas percobaan diajari menggunakan cerita pendek untuk melihat efek dari teknik tersebut.

Untuk memperoleh data, pre-test dan post-test, peneliti digunakan sebagai instrumen. Data yang diperoleh dianalisis menggunakan statistik deskriptif dan teknik analisis statistik parametrik melalui program SPSS versi 22.00. Hasil uji normalitas menggunakan Saphiro-wilk menunjukkan distribusi normal; dan hasil uji homogenitas menggunakan uji Levene menunjukkan variasi yang homogen. Hasil dari penelitian ini adalah bahwa cerita pendek memiliki pengaruh yang signifikan terhadap keterampilan berbicara siswa kelas delapan. Hal ini dapat dilihat dari nilai rata-rata pre-test dan post-test dari kedua kelompok, yaitu, 38,50 dan 39,23 untuk kelompok control dan 39,00 dan 44,40. Berdasarkan hasil uji hipotesis menggunakan paired sample t-test, ditemukan bahwa sig (2-tailed) (.000) lebih besar dari Sig.  $\alpha$  (0,05). Temuan menunjukkan bahwa  $H_0$  diterima dan  $H_a$  tidak diterima. Kesimpulan dari penelitian ini adalah cerita pendek memiliki pengaruh yang signifikan terhadap keterampilan berbicara siswa kelas delapan. Berdasarkan uraian di atas, disarankan agar guru menggunakan cerita pendek yang dapat meningkatkan keterampilan berbicara siswa.

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#### **ABSTRACT**

This research aimed to investigate whether short stories use was effective to develop students' speaking at SMPN 160 Jakarta. This study was carried out by using the control and the experimental method with one group pretest-posttest design. The population of this research was the eighth graders of SMP N 160 Jakarta in 2017/2018 the academic year. The sample was use group eight E and D students'. They were taught speaking using short stories to see the effect of that technique.

To obtain the data, pre-test and post-test were administered. The data obtained were analyzed using the descriptive statistic and parametric statistic analysis technique through SPSS version 22.00 program. The result of normality test using Saphiro-wilk showed normal distribution; and the result of homogeneity test using Levene's test showed homogeneous variances. The result of this research was that short stories had significant effect on the eighth graders' speaking skill. It can be seen from the mean scores of pre-test and post-test of both group, which were, 38,50 and 39,23 for the control group and 39.00 and 44.40 for the experimental group. Based on the result of hypothesis test using the paired sample t-test, it was found that sig (2-tailed) (.000) was greater than Sig.  $\alpha$  (0.05). The findings indicated that H<sub>0</sub> was accepted and H $\alpha$  was not accepted. The conclusion of this research was Short story had significant effect on the eighth graders' speaking skill. Based on the descriptions above, it is recommended for use short story to improve students' speaking skill.
