Industri Perasuransi

1stKondisi perekonomian Indonesia pada tahun 2011 menunjukkan pertumbuhan yang cukup menggembirakan¹⁾. Hal ini terlihat dari Pendapatan Domestik Bruto (PDB) tahun 2011 yang mengalami pertumbuhan sebesar 6,5% dibandingkan dengan tahun 2010²⁾. Selain itu, tingkat inflasi tahun 2011 berada di angka 3,79% lebih rendah 3.17% jika dibandingkan tingkat inflasi tahun sebelumnya yang berada pada angka 6,96%³⁾.

2ndKondisi tersebut berdampak positif terhadap perkembangan industri perasuransi, yang terlihat dari peningkatan beberapa indikator utama seperti total aset, total investasi, dan total premi bruto¹⁾. Di tahun 2011, total aset perusahaan asuransi dan perusahaan reasuransi meningkat sebesar 18,84% dibandingkan dengan posisi pada akhir tahun 2010 atau nilainya meningkat dari Rp 405,16 triliun menjadi Rp 481,50 triliun²⁾. Sebesar 87,30% atau Rp 420,35 triliun dari total aset perusahaan asuransi dan perusahaan reasuransi tersebut ditempatkan dalam berbagai instrumen

investasi³⁾. Total investasi ini mengalami kenaikan sebesar 17,93% bila dibandingkan dengan tahun 2010 yang bernilai Rp 356,45 triliun⁴⁾.

3rdDari sisi perolehan premi, selama tahun 2011, total premi yang dihimpun mengalami kenaikan 29,58% dibandingkan dengan tahun 2010, yaitu dari Rp 125,07 triliun menjadi Rp 162,07 triliun¹⁾. Total nilai premi tersebut mencapai 2,18% dari PDB tahun 2011²⁾. Adapun premi per jumlah penduduk atau densitas asuransi pada periode yang sama mencapai Rp 672.497 per orang³⁾.

The total value of the premiums reached 2.18% of GDP in 2011²⁾. Meanwhile premium per number of inhabitants or insurance density in the same period reached USD 672 497 per person³⁾.

Insurance Industry

1st Indonesia economic condition showed an uplifting growth in 2011¹⁾. It was shown from the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) which experienced an increase by 6,5% compared to 2010²⁾. Meanwhile, inflation rate in 2011 was 3.79% or lower 3.17% compared to inflation rate of last year, which was 6,96%³⁾.

2nd Those conditions gave positive impact toward insurance industry development shown from the positive growth of major financial indicators, e.g. total assets, total investment, and total gross premium¹⁾. In 2011, total assets of insurance and reinsurance companies increased by 18.84% compared to 2010, from Rp 405.16 trillion to Rp 481.50 trillion²⁾. Insurance and reinsurance companies has placed 87.30% of the toal assets or Rp 420.35 trillion in various investment instruments³⁾.

The total investment experienced an increase by 17.93% compared to 2010, which was Rp 356.45 trillion⁴⁾.

3rd In term of premium, total gross premium collected went up by 29.58%, from Rp 125.07 trillion to Rp 162.07 trillion¹⁾. Total of such premium was 2.18% of GDP in 2011²⁾. The gross premium per total population or insurance density at the same period was Rp 672,497 per person³⁾.

1st Sepanjang 2011 pasar saham mengalami gejolak akibat krisis yang melanda negara-negara Eropa dan Amerika Serikat, sehingga kinerja indeks dari bursa global, termasuk IHSG mengalami penurunan¹⁾. Namun demikian, bagi IHSG, kondisi tersebut tidak berlangsung berkepanjangan, sehingga mampu mendorong minat investor baik investor asing maupun investor domestik untuk kembali berinvestasi di pasar saham²⁾. Hal ini dapat terlihat dari kinerja IHSG, yang pada tahun 2011 kembali mencatat prestasi sebagai indeks dengan kinerja terbaik kedua setelah Bursa Efek Philipina³⁾. 2nd Seiring penguatan IHSG, nilai kapitalisasi pasar saham BEI juga mengalami peningkatan sebesar 8,94% dari Rp 3.247,10 triliun pada akhir tahun 2010 menjadi Rp 3.537,29 triliun pada akhir tahun 2011¹⁾. Total nilai transaksi saham juga mengalami peningkatan sebesar 4,01% dari Rp 1.176,24 triliun di tahun 2010

menjadi Rp 1.223,44 triliun di tahun 2011²⁾. Kondisi yang sama terjadi pada nilai transaksi rata-rata harian, nilainya meningkat dari Rp 4,80 triliun per hari pada tahun 2010 menjadi Rp 4,95 triliun per hari pada tahun 2011³⁾.

3rdDari total nilai transaksi saham senilai Rp 1.223,44 triliun tersebut, sebesar 64,93% atau Rp 794,34 triliun dilakukan oleh investor domestik sedangkan sisanya sebesar Rp 429,09 triliun atau 35,07% dilakukan oleh investor asing¹⁾. Dilihat dari nilai bersih transaksi saham yang dilakukan oleh investor asing, sepanjang tahun 2011 terjadi aliran masuk dana asing sebesar Rp 24,29 triliun²⁾. Jumlah tersebut mengalami peningkatan dibandingkan tahun 2010 dimana aliran masuk dana asing nilainya sebesar Rp 20,98 triliun³⁾.

4thDi tengah gejolak ekonomi dunia dan melemahnya indeks-indeks saham lain termasuk di kawasan Asia Pasifik, Indeks Harga Saham Gabungan (IHSG) Bursa Efek Indonesia (BEI) berhasil mencatatkan diri sebagai indeks berkinerja terbaik kedua setelah Bursa Efek Filipina¹⁾. Pencapaian tersebut tentu saja tidak lepas dari kerja keras regulator dan pelaku industri serta dukungan pemerintah melalui kebijakan ekonomi dan politik yang mampu menciptakan iklim yang kondusif bagi industri pasar modal²⁾. Sepanjang tahun 2011, beberapa kebijakan strategis untuk

memperkuat industri efek masih menjadi fokus perhatian Bappepam-LK, baik berupa inisiatif baru maupun kelanjutan dari inisiatif strategi tahun sebelumnya³⁾.

1stIn 2011 the stock market turmoil as a result of crises in European countries and the United States, so that the performance index of global stock markets, including stock index declined¹⁾. Nevertheless, the CSPI, the condition did not last prolonged, so as to encourage investors both foreign investors and domestic investors to re-invest in the stock market²⁾. It can be seen from the JCI, which in 2011 re-record of achievement as an index with the second best performance after the Philippine Stock Exchange³⁾. On the date August 1, 2011 JCI touched its highest level for the year 2011, which stood at 4193.44 and experience the lowest point on the position of 3269.45 on October 4, 2011⁴⁾.

2ndAlong JCI, BEI stock market capitalization also increased by 8.94% from Rp 3247.10 billion at year-end 2010 to Rp 3537.29 billion at the end of 2011¹⁾. Total stock transaction value also increased by 4.01% from Rp 1176.24 billion in 2010 to Rp 1223.44 billion in 2011²⁾. Similar conditions occur in the average value of daily

transactions, the value increased from Rp 4.80 trillion per day in 2010 to Rp 4.95 trillion per day in 2011³⁾.

3rd Of the total value of the stock transaction valued at Rp 1223.44 trillion, amounting to 64.93% or Rp 794.34 trillion committed by domestic investors while the remaining Rp 429.09 trillion or 35.07% by foreign investors¹⁾. Judging from the net value of stock transactions carried out by foreign investors, during the year 2011 occurred inflows of foreign funds amounting to Rp 24.29 trillion²⁾. That number has increased from 2010 in which the inflow of foreign funds worth Rp 20.98 trillion³⁾.

4th In the midst of global economic turmoil and the weakening of other stock indices, including the Asia Pacific region, the Composite Stock Price Index (CSPI) Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) successfully signed up as the second best performing index after the Philippine Stock Exchange¹⁾. The achievement is certainly not the hard work of regulators and industry as well as government support through political and economic policies that are able to create a conducive environment for the capital markets industry²⁾. Throughout 2011, several strategic policy to strengthen the securities industry is still the focus of attention Bapepam-LK, in the form of new initiatives and the continuation of the previous year strategy initiative³⁾.

Securities Industry

1stThroughout 2011, stock market fluctuated due to economic crisis of countries in Europe and United States of America, causing a declining in index performance of global exchanges and Composite Stock Price index (CSPI)¹⁾. Yet, such condition only lasted for a while to CSPI²⁾. So it could encourage the investors' interest, both foreign and domestic investors, to invest in stock market³⁾. It was reflected from CSPI performance which recorded another great achievement in 2011 as the second best performance index after Philippine Stock Exchange⁴⁾. On August 1, 2011, CSPI successfully reached the highest point in 2011 at 4,193.44 and the lowest point at 3,269.45 on October 4, 2011⁵⁾.

2ndIn line with CPSI strengthening, market capitalization value of IDX shares also experienced an increase by 8.94% from Rp 3,247.10 trillion at the end of 2010 to Rp 3,537.29 trillion in 2011¹⁾. Total value of stock transaction increased by 4.01% from Rp 1,176.24 trillion in 2010 to Rp 1,233.44 trillion in 2011²⁾. Likewise,

daily average transaction value also experienced an increase from Rp 4,80 trillion per day in 2010 to Rp 4.95 trillion per day in 2011³⁾.

3rd From total stock transaction value of Rp 1,223.44 trillion, 64.93% or Rp 794.34 trillion of which were performed by domestic investors, while the rest of Rp 429.09 trillion or 35.07% came from foreign investors¹⁾. Additionally, net stock transaction value performed by foreign investors inflicted net inflow of foreign capital by Rp 24.29 trillion²⁾. The figures reflected a positive growth compared to 2010 performance which was Rp 20.98 trillion³⁾.

4th In the global economic turmoil and the weakening of other stock indices, including in the Asia Pasific region, The Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) Composite Stock Price Index (CSPI) was recorded as the second best performance index following Philippine Stock Exchange¹⁾. Certainly, such achievement was the result of the hard work of the regulator and industry players²⁾. In addition, the support from the government through economic and political policies has provided a conducive climate to the capital market industry³⁾. Throughout 2011, some strategic policies aimed at strengthening at the securities industry have become Bapepam-LK focus, either in term of new initiatives or contuniation of last year's strategic initiatives⁴⁾.

SBY ke Fiji, Perkuat Hubungan RI dengan Kawasan Pasifik

1st Guna mempererat hubungan Indonesia dengan negara-negara di kawasan Pasifik selatan, Presiden Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono (SBY) melakukan kunjungan kerja ke Fiji selama tiga hari mulai 17 Juni¹⁾. "Kawasan Pasifik selatan ini penting karena selama 10 tahun terakhir kita telah memperkuat dan menjalin hubungan dengan negara-negara kunci," kata Presiden dalam jumpa pers sebelum bertolak ke Fiji melalui Bandara Halim Perdanakusumah, Jakarta, Selasa pagi²⁾. Menurut SBY, Indonesia selama bertahun-tahun terakhir telah menjalin hubungan baik antara lain dengan negara Timor Leste, Papua Nugini, Australia, dan Selandia Baru³⁾.

2nd Presiden memaparkan hubungan baik dengan negara-negara di kawasan pasifik tersebut juga berangkat dari kesepakatan bahwa mereka semua secara resmi menghormati kedaulatan Republik Indonesia¹⁾. Yudhoyono menuturkan, sebelumnya urusan terkait permasalahan Papua kerap dipersoalkan di tingkat internasional dan hal tersebut bisa diatasi dengan cara menjalin hubungan yang baik dengan negara-negara di pasifik selatan²⁾. Ia mencontohkan bahwa sejumlah ajang seperti Pacific Island

Forum dan Melanesian Spearhead Group sering dijadikan tempat bagi kelompok-kelompok yang mempersoalkan Papua untuk mendapatkan dukungan³⁾.

3rd"Tugas saya adalah meningkatkan kerja sama dan persahabatan serta memberitahukan kebijakan kita tentang Papua," ujar Presiden Yudhoyono¹⁾. Dengan demikian, menurut Presiden, tidak akan ada lagi atau setidaknya mengurangi disinformasi dan misinformasi terkait dengan kebijakan Indonesia mengenai Papua dalam konteks hubungan internasional²⁾. SBY menjelaskan pihaknya sebelumnya juga telah mempersilakan perwakilan Melanesian Spearhead Group untuk datang ke Papua Barat Indonesia guna mendengar langsung terkait dengan kebijakan pembangunan ekonomi serta aspek keamanan di Papua³⁾.

SBY to Fiji, RI Strengthens Relationship with the Pacific Region

1st Indonesia to strengthen the ties with the countries in the south Pacific region, President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono (SBY) on a working visit to Fiji for three days from June 17¹⁾. "South Pacific region is important because over the last 10 years we have strengthened and established relationships with key countries," he said at a press conference before leaving for Fiji through Perdanakusumah Halim Airport, Jakarta, on Tuesday morning²⁾. According to Yudhoyono, Indonesia over the past years have established good relationships with, among others, Timor Leste, Papua New Guinea, Australia, and New Zealand³⁾.

2nd The President explained the good relations with the countries in the Pacific region also departed from the agreement that they all officially respecting the sovereignty of the Republic of Indonesia¹⁾. Yudhoyono said that, prior dealings related to Papua problems often questioned at the international level and it can be overcome by having a good relationship with the countries in the south pacific²⁾. He

pointed out that some event such as the Pacific Island Forum and the Melanesian Spearhead Group is often used as a place for groups to get support Papuan question³⁾.

3rd"My job is to improve cooperation and friendship as well as inform our policy on Papua," said President Yudhoyono¹⁾. Thus, according to the president, will no longer exist, or at least reduce the disinformation and misinformation associated with Indonesian policy on Papua in the context of international relations²⁾. SBY has previously explained that the Melanesian Spearhead Group invited representatives to come to West Papua Indonesia to hear directly related to economic development policies as well as security aspects in Papua³⁾.

Indonesian President to Strengthen Bilateral Relations with Pacific Countries

1st Indonesian President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono's three-day working visit to Fiji from June 17 to 19, 2014, aims to strengthen bilateral relations with countries in the South Pacific region¹⁾. "The South Pacific region is important, and therefore, since the past ten years we have strengthened our relations with key countries," Yudhoyono remarked during a press conference before leaving the Halim Perdanakusuma Air Force Base, Jakarta, for Fiji on Tuesday morning²⁾. Yudhoyono noted that over the years, Indonesia has worked towards building good relations with Timor Leste, Papua New Guinea, Australia, and New Zealand, among others³⁾.

2nd Indonesian head of state explained that good relations with countries in the Pacific region were based on an agreement that they respected the sovereignty of the Republic of Indonesia¹⁾. According to him, the Papua issue was frequently debated at the international level, but it can be resolved by fostering sound bilateral relations with the countries in South Pacific²⁾. Yudhoyono stated that several events, such as the Pacific Island Forum and Melanesian Spearhead Group were frequently used by certain groups to raise the Papua issue³⁾.

3rd"But, my task is to improve cooperation and friendship with South Pacific countries and to explain them about our policy with regard to Papua," then he noted¹⁾. According to Yudhoyono, cooperation and friendship with the South Pacific countries can reduce disinformation and misinformation about the Indonesian policy toward Papua in the context of international relations²⁾. He further added that he had ever allowed the representative of the Melanesian Spearhead Group to come to Papua to gain first-hand information about the economic development policy and security aspects³⁾.

Korea Utara Diprotes Jepang setelah Luncurkan Rudal

1stJepang memprotes peluncuran rudal Korea Utara, Minggu, tetapi mengatakan akan tetap melakukan perundingan antarpemerintah seperti yang sudah direncanakan pekan ini¹⁾. "Jepang mengajukan protes keras kepada Korea Utara melalui Kedutaan (di Beijing)," kata Menteri Luar Negeri Fumio Kishida kepada wartawan, seperti dilansir Yahoo News²⁾. Ia menambahkan, bagaimana pun keadaan itu tidak akan mengubah perundingan resmi para pejabat kedua negara yang dijadwalkan berlangsung di Beijing, Selasa depan³⁾. Pertemuan itu bertujuan melihat perkembangan janji Pyongyang untuk menyelidiki nasib warga Jepang yang menjadi korban penculikan oleh agen-agen Korea Utara pada masa Perang Dingin⁴⁾.

2ndSeorang pejabat pertahanan Korea Selatan mengatakan bahwa Korut meluncurkan dua rudal ke Laut Jepang (Laut Timur)¹⁾. Keduanya mendarat di perairan internasional²⁾. "Pada konsultasi di tingkat pemerintah, kami ingin mengangkat masalah (rudal) ini dengan tegas," kata Kishida³⁾. "Meski pun pertemuan

itu akan membahas masalah penculikan, kami memandang kegiatan itu merupakan peluang yang baik untuk juga membahas masalah nuklir dan rudal⁴⁾."

3rdPertemuan dilakukan hampir satu bulan setelah Tokyo mengumumkan akan menghapuskan sanksi bagi Korut apabila negara itu menyelidiki ulang kasus penculikan -- masalah yang sudah bertahun-tahun ingin diselesaikan oleh Perdana Menteri Shinzo Abe¹⁾. Jepang mengatakan bahwa penyelidikan itu harus mendasar dan dapat dipercaya, sebelum mencabut sanksi sepihak²⁾. Korea Utara pada 2002 mengakui telah menculik 13 warga Jepang antara tahun 1970-an hingga 1980an untuk melatih mata-mata Korut dengan bahasa dan budaya Jepang³⁾. Lima dari korban penculikan itu sudah dipulangkan tetapi Pyongyang mengatakan --tanpa disertai bukti -- bahwa delapan orang yang lain sudah meninggal sehingga memicu kegemparan di Jepang⁴⁾. Sikap enggan Korut untuk menyelesaikan masalah penculikan ini demikian pula mengenai program nuklir dan rudal telah membuat pembicaraan mengenai normalisasi hubungan kedua negara keluar jalur⁵⁾.

North Korea protested after Launches Missiles Japan

1st Japanese protest against North Korea's missile launch on Sunday, but said it would remain intergovernmental negotiations as planned this week¹⁾. "Japan protested strongly to North Korea through the Embassy (in Beijing)," said Foreign Minister Fumio Kishida told reporters, as reported by Yahoo News²⁾. He added, however it will not change the state of official talks between the two countries are scheduled to take place in Beijing, next Tuesday³⁾. The meeting aims to look at the development of Pyongyang's promise to investigate the fate of Japanese citizens abducted by North Korean agents during the Cold War⁴⁾.

2nd A South Korean defense official said that North Korea launched two missiles into the Sea of Japan (East Sea)¹⁾. Both landed in international waters²⁾. "In consultations at government level, we would like to raise the issue (missile) with the firm," said Kishida³⁾. "Even though the meeting will discuss the abduction issue, we

look at the activities it is a good opportunity to also discuss nuclear issues and missiles⁴⁾."

3rdThe meeting was held nearly a month after Tokyo announced it would abolish sanctions for North Korea if the country re-investigate cases of abduction - problems that have for years wanted resolved by Prime Minister Shinzo Abe¹⁾. Japan said that the investigation should be basic and trustworthy, before lifting sanctions unilaterally²⁾. North Korea in 2002 admitted abducting 13 Japanese citizens in the 1970s to the 1980s to train North Korean spies in Japanese language and culture³⁾. Five of the abductees have been repatriated, but Pyongyang said - without any evidence - that eight others had died, triggering an uproar in Japan⁴⁾. North Korea's reluctance to resolve the abduction issue as well as the nuclear and missile program has made talks on normalizing relations between the two countries off track⁵⁾.

Japan Protested Against North Korea's Ballistic Missile Launch

1st Japan protested against North Korea's ballistic missile launch Sunday, June 29, but vowed to go ahead with rare government-level talks with Pyongyang this week as scheduled¹⁾ ."Japan for its part lodged a stern protest with the North Korean side through embassy channels (in Beijing)," Foreign Minister Fumio Kishida told reporters²⁾ .He added, however, that there would be no change in the official talks scheduled for Tuesday in Beijing³⁾ .The meeting is aimed at checking progress in Pyongyang's promised investigation into the fate of Japanese citizens abducted by North Korean agents during the Cold War⁴⁾ .

2nd A South Korean defense ministry official said the North fired two ballistic missiles into the Sea of Japan (East Sea) from its east coast¹⁾ . Both landed in international waters, he said²⁾ ."At the government-level consultations, we want to raise the (missile) issue resolutely," Kishida said³⁾ .
