Reviewer #1:

- 2. While you mention using a qualitative research design, the abstract lacks details about the research methodology and data collection process. It would be beneficial to briefly describe how the legal counseling activities were conducted, including the number of participants, the selection process, and the criteria for measuring community legal awareness.
- 3. The abstract should briefly touch on the key findings or insights obtained from the research. Providing a summary of the most significant results will give readers a better understanding of the study's implications. For example, you could mention specific changes in community legal awareness levels.
- 4. The keywords "Community Legal Awareness," "Land Right," and "Disputes" are relevant, but "Enhancing" is quite generic. It would be advisable to replace it with a more specific keyword that reflects the primary focus of the study, such as "Legal Aid Institutions" or "Qualitative Research."
- 5. Ensure that you include proper citations and references in your journal article. This will strengthen the credibility of your research. Mention any key sources that influenced the study or are relevant to the topic of enhancing community legal awareness.

- Although you describe the research as qualitative, it appears that some quantitative elements, such as the number of participants or data points, are involved. Clarify if any quantitative data was collected and, if so, provide a brief summary of these statistics, which may add depth to your findings.
- Ensure that the language used in the abstract is precise and free from grammatical errors. A clear, wellstructured, and grammatically sound abstract is crucial for conveying professionalism and ensuring the research is easily understood by a wide audience.


