Reviewer #1:

1. The abstract provides a broad overview of character education and its impact on human resources. However, it would be beneficial to specify the main objectives and research questions of the study more explicitly. This will help readers understand the key focus of the research from the outset.
2. The abstract briefly mentions the use of "*library research*" as the research method. It would be helpful to elaborate on the theoretical framework that guided this research and the specific sources or databases used for the literature review. This will provide readers with a clearer understanding of the academic foundations of the study.
3. While the abstract mentions using "published research results," it should explicitly list some of the sources or studies that were consulted. Additionally, citing key references related to character education and its impact on human resources can enhance the academic credibility of the study.
4. The abstract repeats the idea that character education leads to better human resources, which, in turn, reduces future corruption. While this is a crucial point, the abstract could benefit from more concise language to avoid redundancy and maintain the reader's engagement.
5. The provided keywords are relevant, but it might be helpful to add a few more specific keywords or phrases related to character education, such as "*moral values*," "*educational environment*," or "*corruption prevention*." This will improve the article's discoverability and relevance for readers interested in these topics.

#Reviewer 2:

Providing more information on the search strategy and data selection process will enhance the transparency and replicability of the research.
2. The abstract discusses the importance of character education but lacks specific examples or case studies to illustrate how character education has been successfully implemented in different settings. Including such empirical evidence can make the argument more compelling and relatable to the readers.
3. To strengthen the argument regarding the impact of character education on human resources and corruption prevention, consider including statistical data or quantitative findings, if available. This will provide a more robust basis for the claims made in the abstract.
4. The abstract mentions that educators should teach based on religious moral values, Pancasila, and local wisdom. However, it would be beneficial to clarify how educators can effectively incorporate these values into their teaching methods and curriculum. Providing practical insights or recommendations for educators would be valuable.
5. The abstract briefly concludes that character education needs improvement in both the family and educational environments. It would be helpful to briefly outline the practical implications of this research. For example, what policy recommendations or actionable steps can be derived from the findings to promote character education effectively?
