Reviewer #1:

However, it would be beneficial to provide more specific details about the questionnaire and how it measures cultural sensitivity. This will help readers understand the study's approach more comprehensively.
2. While the abstract mentions diverse findings on cultural sensitivity based on various factors, it would be helpful to provide a brief summary of these findings. This would give readers a sense of the key takeaways from the study without delving into the details.
3. The abstract mentions that the findings have implications for educational knowledge and professional practice, especially for lecturers and higher education. It would be beneficial to briefly outline these implications in more detail. What specific actions or changes are suggested by the study's results?
4. The abstract is quite long and contains complex sentences. It might benefit from simplifying some of the language for better readability. Try to convey the same information in a more concise and straightforward manner without losing essential details.
5. While the keywords are appropriate, it would be beneficial to add a few more relevant keywords that researchers in the field might use when searching for articles on this topic. This can help improve the discoverability of the article.

Including a brief summary of key statistical results and their implications will give readers a clearer understanding of the study's outcomes.
3. The abstract highlights the use of Facebook and Instagram for the study but does not explain why these platforms were chosen or how they relate to cultural sensitivity. Providing a brief rationale for selecting these particular social media platforms and their relevance to the research topic would strengthen the article's foundation.
4. It would be valuable to include a sentence or two in the abstract suggesting directions for future research in this area. What aspects of cultural sensitivity or social media use could be explored in subsequent studies, building upon the findings of this research?
5. The abstract could benefit from a concluding sentence that summarizes the key takeaway or main message of the research. This can help readers grasp the significance of the study at a glance.
