Reviewer #1:

- 1. The abstract provides an overview of the study's goals and findings. However, it could benefit from more specific details about the research methodology, such as the data collection and analysis techniques employed. This would enhance the reader's understanding of the study's rigor and the exact nature of the relationships discovered.
- 2. The abstract mentions the use of a random sample of 96 lecturers out of 335. It would be helpful to elaborate on the criteria for selecting this sample and whether it accurately represents the larger population of lecturers at the Christian University of Indonesia. A discussion of potential biases or limitations in the sampling process would strengthen the study's validity.
- 3. The abstract suggests positive relationships between professionalism, intelligence, and environmental insight but does not address the direction of these relationships. It would be beneficial to discuss whether high professionalism and intelligence cause an increase in environmental insight or vice versa. This clarification would provide a deeper insight into the study's implications.
- 4. The abstract mentions positive relationships, but it lacks information about the statistical analysis used and the significance levels of these relationships. Including statistical measures like correlation coefficients and p-values would offer a more precise understanding of the findings and the strength of these relationships.
- 5. The abstract concludes that higher professionalism and intelligence lead to greater environmental insight. However, it could be improved by discussing the practical implications of these findings. How might these results benefit the university or inform the development of lecturer training programs? Providing some context and practical implications would make the study more relevant to the academic community.
