Reviewer #1:

- 1. The abstract mentions that pre-service English foreign language teachers have an excellent level of soft skills, but it would greatly enhance the article if the specific soft skills assessed are clearly outlined. A breakdown of the soft skills evaluated and their importance in the teaching context would provide a more nuanced understanding for readers and educators.
- 2. The methodology section could benefit from additional details regarding the questionnaire used for data collection. Specify the constructs measured, the scale employed, and any reliability/validity testing conducted. A comprehensive description of the research instrument would not only strengthen the study's credibility but also facilitate replication by other researchers.
- 3. While the abstract indicates a positive relationship between pre-service teachers' skills and achievement, a brief elaboration on the statistical methods employed would enhance the reader's comprehension. Including information on the statistical tests used and their appropriateness for the data would provide a clearer picture of the study's analytical rigor.
- 4. The discussion section could delve deeper into the implications of the findings. How do the identified soft skills correlate with specific academic achievements? Providing concrete examples or scenarios where these skills prove crucial would add substance to the discussion and aid educators in understanding the practical applications of the study's outcomes.
- 5. The conclusion suggests initiatives for improving the marketability of graduates based on the study's findings. It would be valuable to include specific recommendations for future research. Identifying potential areas for further investigation, perhaps in different educational contexts or with different variables, would contribute to the scholarly dialogue on pre-service teachers' skills and achievement.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
