 Additionally, elaborating on any challenges faced during the research and how they were addressed would add
 depth to the methodology section.
- 2. While discussing the Sasi system's effectiveness in forest protection, consider integrating perspectives from local communities and stakeholders. Including direct quotes or narratives from individuals affected by or involved in the Sasi practices could add a human dimension to the study, enriching its qualitative aspects and making it more relatable to readers.
- 3. The article mentions the research period as January to March 2021, post-COVID-19 pandemic. To ensure the study's temporal relevance and external validity, discuss how the pandemic context specifically influenced the Sasi practices during this period. This could involve exploring changes in community dynamics, resource management, or the enforcement of environmental laws in the aftermath of the pandemic.
- 4. Consider expanding the discussion by incorporating a comparative analysis with similar environmental protection practices in other regions or communities. This could provide readers with a broader understanding of the uniqueness of Sasi in Ambon Island and contribute to the global discourse on sustainable environmental management practices.
- 5. To enhance the article's academic rigor, explicitly address potential limitations of the study. Acknowledge any constraints in the research design, data collection, or analysis, and discuss how these limitations might impact the generalizability of the findings. This transparency strengthens the article by demonstrating a thoughtful reflection on the study's scope and potential areas for future research.
- 6. The article efficiently employs a document checklist for data analysis. However, to bolster the article's credibility, consider presenting excerpts or examples from the documents studied to illustrate key points. Providing snippets of the actual regulations or reports within the article could enhance transparency and allow readers to better grasp the nuances of the Sasi system.

- 7. While the results section highlights the traditional Sasi wisdom and its values, consider organizing the findings thematically to enhance clarity. For instance, categorize the results under distinct themes such as forest protection, water source conservation, and sustainable agriculture. This thematic structure would make it easier for readers to follow the key outcomes of the study.
- The article mentions the use of normative legal research, but a more detailed explanation of how this method was applied would be beneficial. Elaborate on the legal theories or frameworks that guided the analysis of documents related to indigenous peoples' local wisdom. This additional information would provide readers with a clearer understanding of the analytical approach taken.
- While the article effectively discusses the theoretical aspects of Sasi in post-COVID-19 forest protection, consider incorporating a section on the practical implications of the research. Discuss how the findings can inform policy, contribute to community-based conservation efforts, or guide sustainable resource management practices. This practical dimension adds real-world relevance to the academic insights.
- 10. To enhance reader engagement, consider incorporating visual elements such as figures, charts, or graphs that depict key findings or trends. Visual representation of data can make complex information more accessible and aid in conveying the significance of the study's results. Ensure that these visuals are appropriately labeled and explained in the text.
