ABSTRACT

The use of short stories for school learning is an effective learning media for students. This study aims to describe what are the students' perception of using Short Story to develop vocabulary. The study was conducted at SMP Regina Caeli Cileungsi in April 2020. This study involved 59 respondents filling out an online questionnaire. The Respondents were taken from students in class VIII. Quantitative data were collected by using a questionnaire and analyzed using descriptive analysis techniques. Based on the result of the study, it was concluded that the majority of students at SMP Regina Caeli Cileungsi stated that the use of a short story was very helpful in developing vocabulary.
