Reviewer:

- 1. Clarity of Research Objectives: The research objectives need to be explicitly stated in the abstract. It would be beneficial to clearly outline the main goals and specific aims of the study.
- 2. **Methodological Rigor:** Provide more details on the sampling technique employed in selecting the four villages. A transparent explanation of the sampling method strengthens the study's methodology.
- **3. Data Collection Techniques:** Elaborate on the Independent Interview and Focus Group Discussion (FGD) techniques. Specify how these methods were applied to ensure data reliability and validity.
- **4. Temporal Considerations:** Mention the rationale for choosing the specific period (September to December 2019). Did any events or seasons during this time impact the study? This information would contribute to a more comprehensive understanding.
- 5. **Source Credibility:** Assess the reliability of the primary and secondary data sources. Provide details on how the researchers ensured the authenticity and credibility of the information gathered.
- **6. Thematic Analysis:** The abstract mentions "*descriptive analysis*"; consider expanding on the specific thematic analysis approach employed. This would offer readers a clearer understanding of how data were interpreted.
- 7. Findings Presentation: The findings need to be presented more coherently. Consider structuring them into clear subsections or themes to enhance readability.
- 8. **Contrast and Comparison:** While discussing the perceptions of the Asmat Tribe, include a comparative analysis with existing literature or studies. This would add depth and context to the findings.
- **9. Conceptual Framework:** Explicitly state the theoretical framework or conceptual model guiding the study. This would help readers understand the theoretical underpinnings of the research.
- 10. **Discussion Implications:** Expand on the implications of the findings. How might the identified perceptions impact the broader understanding of parenting styles, especially within cultural contexts? This could strengthen the significance of the study.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
