Reviewer:

- 1. Clarity and Specificity of Objectives:** The objectives of the study are not explicitly stated in the abstract. It would be beneficial to clearly outline the specific goals or hypotheses that the research aims to address to provide a clearer direction for readers.
- 2. Detailed Methodological Explanation:** The description of the research method is brief. Providing more details about the scaffolding method and its application in the classroom action research, including any variations or adaptations made, would enhance the understanding of the study's design.
- 3. Measurement Tools Explanation:** While the abstract mentions the use of test sheets and observation sheets, it lacks details about the specific criteria or rubrics used for evaluation. Including information on the assessment criteria would contribute to the transparency of the research.
- 4. Statistical Analysis Elaboration:** The abstract mentions the use of descriptive statistics for data analysis but lacks information on the specific statistical measures employed. Providing more details on the statistical methods used would strengthen the methodological rigor of the study.
- 5. Results Presentation:** The abstract provides a general statement about the positive impact of scaffolding on speaking achievement. However, it lacks specific results or findings. Including key quantitative or qualitative outcomes from the study would enrich the abstract.
- 6. Limitations Acknowledgment:** It would be beneficial to include a brief acknowledgment of any limitations or constraints encountered during the research. This can provide a more realistic context for readers and researchers interpreting the study.
- 7. Keywords Clarification:** The keywords "Effectiveness," "Scaffolding Method," and "Speaking Achievement" are mentioned, but their specific relevance to the study is not elaborated. Providing brief explanations of how these keywords relate to the research would enhance the abstract's clarity.
- 8. Contextual Details:** The abstract lacks contextual details about the students involved, such as their proficiency levels or any specific challenges they may face in speaking skills. Including such information would add depth to the study.

- 9. Recommendation Expansion:** The conclusion briefly suggests using scaffolding in speaking classes. Expanding on this recommendation by providing insights into the potential benefits and practical implementation strategies would be valuable.
- 10. Consistent Terminology:** The abstract uses both "scaffolding method" and "scaffolding." It would be advisable to maintain consistency in terminology throughout the abstract to avoid any confusion among readers.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
