- 3. Elaboration on Social Behavior Patterns: The first condition regarding poor social behavior patterns at home could be further elaborated. What specific behaviors are considered detrimental, and how do these patterns contribute to the challenges faced by children in adolescence and adulthood?
- 4. Model of Behavior Illustration: When discussing the importance of the home providing a model of behavior to imitate, consider including real-life examples or case studies to illustrate this point. This will make the concept more tangible for readers.
