- **4. Instrument Validation:** Include information on the validation process of the interview instrument based on Olivier and Hipp's professional learning community model. Highlight any modifications made to suit the study's context and ensure the tool's reliability and validity.
- **5. Results Presentation:** Provide more specific examples or instances from the study's results to illustrate the effectiveness of the professional learning community in school improvement practices. Concrete examples will enrich the discussion and provide a deeper understanding.
- 6. Linkage to Previous Research: Integrate a brief discussion linking your findings to existing literature. Highlight how your results contribute to or challenge existing knowledge on professional learning communities, especially in the context of English language teaching.
- 7. Address Limitations: Explicitly mention any limitations in the study, such as potential biases or constraints, to enhance the transparency of the research. Acknowledging limitations will strengthen the overall credibility of the findings.
- **8. Application Implications:** Discuss practical implications of the study's findings for English teachers and school administrators. How can the insights gained from the research contribute to the enhancement of professional learning communities in similar educational settings?

- 9. Perspective Inclusion: Consider incorporating students' direct quotes or anecdotes in the results section to provide a more nuanced understanding of their perspectives on the professional learning community. This would add depth to the qualitative findings.
- 10. Keywords Clarification: Clarify the term "im-plementation" in the keywords section. Ensure consistency in spelling and accuracy. Consider providing a brief explanation of this term to avoid ambiguity for readers unfamiliar with the specific context.
