- 7. Strengthen Conclusion: The conclusion could be strengthened by summarizing key findings and their implications more explicitly. Clearly articulate the practical implications of the research for educators and language learners.

- **10. Incorporate Limitations:** It would be beneficial to include a section discussing the limitations of the study. Acknowledging potential constraints adds transparency and strengthens the overall integrity of the research.
