Reviewer:

- 1. Clarity of Objectives: The paper starts by stating the aim of describing the impact of the HOTS learning model on education quality. However, it would be beneficial to explicitly outline the specific objectives of the study in the abstract to guide readers on what to expect.
- 2. Justification for HOTS Model: While the paper mentions the importance of HOTS in the 21st century and the fourth industrial revolution, it would be helpful to provide more concrete examples or evidence supporting why the HOTS learning model is particularly suitable for addressing the challenges posed by the fourth industrial revolution.
- 3. Elaboration on the Fourth Industrial Revolution: The abstract briefly touches on the fourth industrial revolution, but it would be beneficial to expand on its implications for education. A more detailed exploration of how the revolution has altered the educational landscape would provide context for the necessity of HOTS.
- **4.** Clarity on Research Design: The abstract mentions a qualitative approach with a research library design. Adding a brief explanation of why this approach was chosen and how it enhances the study's validity could contribute to a clearer understanding of the research design.
- Explicit Mention of Research Limitations: A brief acknowledgment of any limitations in the research design or
 potential biases would strengthen the paper's credibility. It's essential to be transparent about the study's
 boundaries.
- **6.** Connection Between HOTS and Creativity: The abstract mentions that HOTS learning develops creativity, but it would be beneficial to explicitly connect how the model fosters creativity in learners. Providing examples or citing relevant literature would strengthen this connection.
- 7. Application of HOTS in Different Educational Levels: While the paper states that the HOTS learning model is suitable for both schools and universities, a more nuanced discussion on how the model adapts to different educational levels would enhance the comprehensiveness of the study.
- **8. Quantitative Data Integration:** Although the paper follows a qualitative approach, integrating some quantitative data or statistical insights, even in a minor capacity, could add depth to the findings and provide a more comprehensive view of the HOTS model's impact.

- 9. Consistency in Terminology: Ensure consistency in the use of terms throughout the abstract. For example, the abstract alternately refers to the "industrial revolution 4.0" and "fourth industrial revolution." Using a consistent term would enhance clarity.
- 10. Conclusion Reflection: The abstract concludes by reiterating that the HOTS learning model improves the quality of education. However, a brief reflection or discussion on the broader implications of the findings for educational policy or practice would provide a stronger conclusion to the abstract.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
