#### Reviewer:

- The abstract clearly outlines the research's objective to evaluate online learning during COVID-19 at Universitas
  Kristen Indonesia. However, it would benefit from a more explicit statement on why this evaluation is crucial or
  what knowledge gap it aims to address.
- 2. While the abstract mentions a qualitative approach, it would be beneficial to briefly elaborate on why this approach was chosen and how it enhances the study's understanding of online learning during the pandemic.
- 3. Provide more details on the demographics of the study participants (lecturers and students) to understand the representativeness of the sample and potential implications on the study's generalizability.
- 4. The abstract mentions questionnaires, interviews, observations, and documentation as instruments. Offering a brief insight into the design and structure of these instruments would enhance the reader's understanding of the data collection process.
- 5. Elaborate on the specific data analysis techniques employed, especially concerning how the CSE-UCLA evaluation model was applied to assess online learning quality at UKI. This will provide a clearer picture of the evaluation process.
- The term "good criteria" is mentioned several times. It would be helpful to explicitly define what criteria are considered "good" within the context of this study. This will contribute to the transparency and replicability of the research.

- 7. While the abstract mentions that the quality level is in "good criteria," more detailed insights into the specific findings and any variations among the components (assessment, planning, implementation, and certification) would add depth to the interpretation.
- 8. Given the unprecedented circumstances of COVID-19, it would be valuable to include any challenges encountered during the online learning evaluation and how these challenges were addressed, providing a more holistic view of the study.
- 9. Consider adding a brief section discussing the practical implications of the study's findings for educators, administrators, or policymakers involved in online learning during challenging circumstances like the pandemic.
- 10. Conclude the abstract by suggesting potential areas for future research. Identifying gaps in the current study and proposing avenues for further exploration will contribute to the broader academic discourse on online learning evaluation.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
