A more elaborate explanation of the methodology, including the selection criteria for respondents, would enhance the study's transparency.
3. **Sample Size and Representation:** The abstract lacks information about the demographics of the respondents, such as their academic backgrounds and language proficiency levels. Providing these details would offer a clearer understanding of the sample's representativeness.
4. **Data Analysis Techniques:** Specify the statistical techniques employed for data analysis. Describing the methods used in the statistical analysis would strengthen the validity of the study's findings and help readers assess the rigor of the research.
5. **Taxonomic Level Explanation:** The abstract mentions using a set of reading comprehension tests based on taxonomic levels. Provide a brief explanation or reference to the taxonomic levels utilized, aiding readers in understanding the assessment's structure and alignment with educational principles.
6. **Result Interpretation:** The conclusion states a "moderate level" of students' reading comprehension without defining what constitutes a moderate level. Offer more clarity by providing specific indicators or benchmarks used to determine the levels of comprehension.
7. **Causation vs. Correlation:** The abstract mentions a significant relationship between reading comprehension and English language achievement. Clarify whether the study aims to establish causation or merely identify correlation, as the distinction is crucial for accurate interpretation.
8. **Practical Implications:** Include a brief discussion on the practical implications of the findings. How can the results inform teaching strategies or educational policies at the Indonesian Maritime Academy, Medan, to enhance students' English language achievement?

9. **Suggestions for Improvement:** Offer recommendations or suggestions for improving reading comprehension among students based on the study's results. This could provide valuable insights for educators and policymakers.
10. **Language and Terminology:** Ensure consistency in language use and terminology throughout the abstract. A careful proofread will help in maintaining a professional and polished presentation of the research.
