- Methodology Clarification: The methodology is briefly outlined; however, more details on the sampling technique and rationale for selecting 50 English education students would strengthen the study's methodological foundation.
- 3. **Instrument Validity:** It would be beneficial to include information on the validity and reliability of the questionnaires used to measure lecturer performance and competency. This strengthens the credibility of the study's findings.
- 4. **Data Analysis Explanation:** Provide a more detailed explanation of the Likert Scale analysis used for questionnaire data. This will aid readers in understanding how responses were interpreted and analyzed.
- 5. **Findings Interpretation:** The conclusion could be more explicit in interpreting the findings. Elaborate on why high school students prefer male language instruction and discuss potential implications for the teaching profession.
- **6. Contextual Information:** Add more contextual information about the private university in East Jakarta to help readers understand the generalizability of the study's findings beyond this specific location.
- 7. **Thorough Literature Review:** Expand the literature review to include a more comprehensive exploration of existing research on gender differences in language instruction. This would provide a stronger theoretical framework for the study.
- 8. **Discussion of Limitations:** Address the limitations of the study, such as the limited sample size and the focus on a single university, to ensure a more balanced interpretation of the findings.

- 9. **Keyword Relevance:** Consider including additional keywords that reflect the study's focus, such as "gender in education" or "language teaching preferences," to enhance searchability and relevance.
- 10. **Language Precision:** The abstract suggests that language instruction should be "more specific and more precise as males' language instruction." Clarify what is meant by "specific" and "precise" in the context of language instruction for a more nuanced understanding.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.
