Editor and reviewer comments:

Reviewer #1:

1. The abstract lacks clarity in certain parts due to grammatical issues. For instance, in the sentence "The web mining process comprises the sequence of operations that are comprises of the different languages those need to be processed effectively," *it would be clearer as "The web mining process comprises a sequence of operations involving different languages that need to be processed effectively."* Ensuring grammatical correctness will enhance the overall readability of the abstract.
2. The abstract briefly mentions the proposed Weighted Hashing Similarity Estimation (WHSE) model but could benefit from a more detailed explanation of how it works. Specifically, elaborating on how the weighted values are assigned and updated in the hashing table for feature estimation would provide a clearer understanding of the model's mechanics.
3. The term "*semantic*" is used multiple times in the abstract, referring to semantic word features and semantic ontology. It would be helpful to maintain consistency in the use of this term throughout the abstract to avoid confusion. Ensuring a uniform usage of terminology enhances the overall cohesion of the article.
4. While the abstract mentions the performance comparison with an existing technique and provides accuracy values, it lacks specific statistical details such as the size of the dataset used or the methodology employed for performance evaluation. Including this information would strengthen the paper by providing a more comprehensive view of the experimental setup and results.
5. The abstract claims a "*3% - 7% improvement than the existing technique for the semantic level.*" It would be beneficial to include a brief discussion on why this improvement is significant and how it contributes to the field. Providing context for the improvement will help readers understand the practical implications of the proposed WHSE model.

I hope you can make improvements as soon as possible and send the revised article again via this email.

Please follow the following revision instructions:

#Reviewer 2:

1. The abstract could be strengthened by adhering to a more conventional structure. Consider organizing it into distinct sections such as background, methodology, results, and conclusion. This would provide a clearer flow of information, making it easier for readers to follow the logical progression of the research.
2. The term "*Cross-Media*" is mentioned in the title, but the abstract does not elaborate on its significance or how it is integrated into the proposed WHSE model. Including a brief explanation of why cross-media aspects are considered and how they contribute to the overall similarity estimation would add depth to the abstract.
3. Acknowledging the limitations of the proposed WHSE model would strengthen the paper's transparency. Explicitly mentioning any constraints, assumptions, or potential challenges in the methodology or implementation will provide a more balanced view for readers and researchers considering the applicability of the model in different scenarios.
4. While the abstract reports high accuracy values (0.98) for the semantic ontology, a deeper understanding could be gained by providing specific precision and recall values. This information is crucial for evaluating the model's performance, especially in scenarios where precision or recall is more critical than overall accuracy.
5. The abstract briefly mentions that the proposed WHSE achieves a ~3% - 7% improvement compared to an existing technique. Expanding on the specific findings or insights that led to this improvement would add substance to the abstract. What aspects of the WHSE model contributed to this enhancement, and how do these findings advance the current state of the art?
