Reviewer #1:

- 1. Comment: The methodology section lacks specific details about the survey design and cluster sampling method. It would be beneficial to provide more clarity on the selection criteria for participants and the survey administration process. This would enhance the reproducibility of the study.
- Comment: While the constructs related to English language anxiety are mentioned, it would be valuable to delve deeper into how these constructs are defined and operationalized in the context of the study. Clear definitions and operationalization will contribute to a more robust understanding of the measured variables.
- 3. Comment: The article briefly mentions the findings but lacks detailed presentation and analysis of the collected data. Including tables, graphs, or other visual aids to illustrate the distribution of anxiety levels among students would enhance the comprehensibility of the results section.
- 4. Comment: The discussion section could benefit from a more in-depth exploration of the implications of the findings. How do the identified factors interact, and what practical recommendations can be drawn from the results? A more detailed discussion would contribute significantly to the overall value of the study.
- 5. Comment: The conclusion provides a general recommendation for teachers to employ diverse strategies but lacks specificity. It would be helpful to suggest particular strategies based on the study's findings, aligning recommendations with the identified factors affecting students' anxiety in learning English.

Detailing the steps taken to ensure the accuracy of the collected data would enhance the trustworthiness of the study.
- 3. Comment: To establish the robustness of the findings, consider discussing the potential for cross-validation. Are there plans for future studies or collaboration with other institutions to verify the results? This would add a layer of validation to the study and increase confidence in the generalizability of the findings.
- 4. Comment: The article could benefit from addressing potential biases in the study, such as selection bias due to the cluster sampling method. Discuss how these biases were mitigated or acknowledge their potential impact on the results. This transparency adds rigor to the study and allows readers to critically assess the findings.
- 5. Comment: While the conclusion suggests that teachers should use diverse strategies, providing concrete examples of such strategies would be highly beneficial. How have other educators successfully alleviated anxiety in language learners? Including practical examples would offer actionable insights for educators and researchers.
